**From the Pen of Ken:**

I think you'd agree that we need a spiritual awakening and a broad sweeping revival in the USA! Don't you? The revival I'm talking about is a sovereign act of God moving on His people to wake up from the doldrums and get in the wave of the Spirit.

According to Barna Research in an article released from the website entitled “The Most Post-Christian Cities in America: 2017” more and more the influence of Christianity is waning. This is sad when one takes into account the basic command of our Lord Jesus is that we are “salt and light” in a world of darkness. Barna states, “Rates of church attendance, religious affiliation, belief in God, prayer and Bible-reading have all been dropping for decades. By consequence, the role of religion in public life has been slowly diminishing, and the church no longer functions with the cultural authority it held in times past. These are unique days for the church in America as it learns what it means to flourish in a new “Post-Christian” era. Barna has developed a metric to determine if one is “post modern.”

To qualify as “post-Christian,” individuals had to meet nine or more of the following factors. “Highly post-Christian” individuals meet 13 or more of the factors (out of these 16 criteria).

- Do not believe in God
- Identify as atheist or agnostic
- Disagree that faith is important in their lives
- Have not prayed to God (in the last week)
- Have never made a commitment to Jesus
- Disagree the Bible is accurate
- Have not donated money to a church (in the last year)
- Have not attended a Christian church (in the last 6 months)
- Agree that Jesus committed sins
- Do not feel a responsibility to “share their faith”
- Have not read the Bible (in the last week)
- Have not volunteered at church (in the last week)
- Have not attended Sunday school (in the last week)
- Have not attended religious small group (in the last week)
- Bible engagement scale: low (have not read the Bible in the past week and disagree strongly or somewhat that the Bible is accurate)
- Not Born Again
